The following guide shows the homework your child can expect as he or she progresses through the school. Parents can also visit our website for spelling lists, details of recommended educational websites and other advice to support your child's learning.

Y0	READING	Word recognition	From October individual flashcards are sent home for families to help the children learn the words by sight.
		Books	From October children are able to take books home to share with parents to allow them to practise their reading skills
		Learning bags	To develop fine motor control, Literacy and Maths skills.
Y1	READING	Reading	Daily books and a reading log to support sight word vocabulary, reading skills and sound blending.
		Spelling	Online word lists weekly, with a range of sounds to focus on, in-line with the new spelling scheme.
	NUMERACY	Tables	Abacus games online linked to weekly maths topic areas. All children provided with a login and personal account.
Y2	LITERACY	Reading	Children to read with families three to four times a week
		Spelling	Weekly spelling lists sent home each Friday and tested the following Friday.
		Word recognition	When necessary, some children will bring home key words to learn
	NUMERACY	Tables	Abacus activities as directed by the class teacher & 2x tables.
Y3	LITERACY	Reading	Children encouraged to read aloud two or three times a week with their family.
		Spelling	Spelling lists sent home each week to learn and tested the following week in class.
	NUMERACY		Abacus activities as directed by the class teacher & 3x, 4x and 8x tables.
	TOPIC WORK		Family learning projects will be set periodically to support in-class learning.
Y4	LITERACY	Reading	Children encouraged to read aloud with their family two or three times a week.
		Spelling	Spelling lists sent home each week to learn and tested the following week in class.
	NUMERACY		Abacus activities as directed by the class teacher & 6x, 7x, 9x, 11x and 12x tables.
	TOPIC WORK		Family learning projects will be set periodically to support in-class learning.
Y5	LITERACY	Reading	Children encouraged to read two or three times a week with their family.
		Spelling	Spelling lists sent home each week to learn and tested the following week in class.
	NUMERACY		Abacus activities as directed by the class teacher and revision of multiplication facts for all times tables.
	SCIENCE & TOPIC WORK		From time to time, humanities, science and further literacy homework tasks will be set. These should be handed in to the relevant teacher as requested, normally on a Tuesday.
Y6	LITERACY	Reading	Reading aloud with an adult at least once a week. Reading Records will be checked each week to monitor progress.
		Spelling	Lists of spellings based on sound patterns are sent home to learn and are tested the following week.
		Writing	Pupils are asked to build up sentences using their spelling words which should take 30 – 45 minutes. Miss Novak's group will also complete additional writing tasks.
	NUMERACY		Abacus activities (or set on paper) as directed by the class teacher and revision of multiplication facts for all times tables.
	SCIENCE & TOPIC WORK		From time to time, humanities, science and further literacy homework tasks will be set. These should be handed in to the relevant teacher as requested, normally on a Tuesday.
