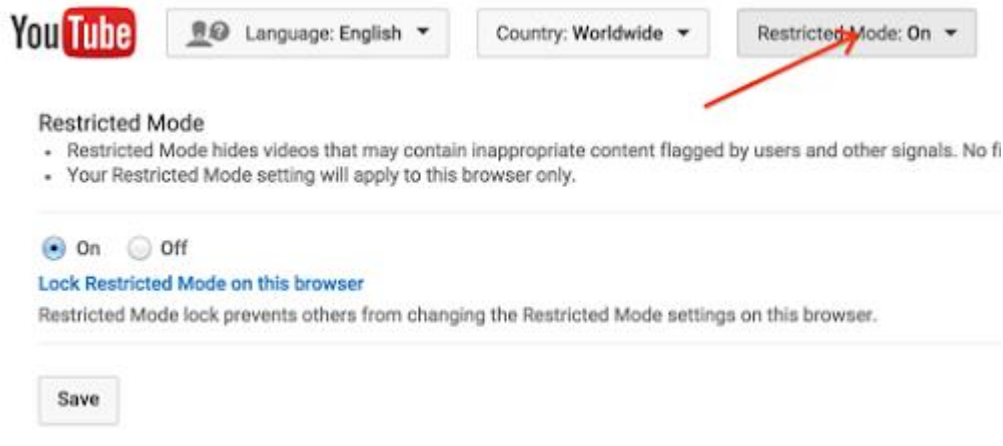



Turn Restricted Mode on or off

1. Scroll to the bottom of any YouTube page and click the **Restricted Mode** drop-down menu.
2. Select **On** or **Off**.
3. Click **Save**.



Once enabled, Restricted Mode remains on, even if you sign out. If another person signs in to their YouTube account, Restricted Mode will still be on. If you want to make sure that other users on the computer can't change the setting, be sure to lock Restricted Mode and sign out of the account.

Android app

1. Sign in to your account.
2. On the top right, tap menu .
3. Select **Settings** > **General**.
4. Turn **Restricted mode** on or off

Android TV

Note: This only controls Restricted Mode on your Android TV.

1. Sign in to your accounts.
2. From the **Home** screen, scroll down to the **Apps** row.
3. Select **YouTube**.
4. Scroll down and select **Settings**.
5. Select **Restricted Mode** or **Safety Mode**.
6. Select **Enabled** or **Disabled**.

iOS app

1. In the top right, tap your account icon.
2. Tap **Settings**.
3. Tap **Restricted Mode Filtering**.
4. Turn Restricted Mode on or off:
 - **Don't filter:** Restricted Mode off
 - **Strict:** Restricted Mode on
